#### Ananias' Response Acts 9:17-18

" Ananias went and entered the house. He placed his hands on him and said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road you were traveling, has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit."

<sup>18</sup> At once something like scales fell from his eyes, and he regained his sight. Then he got up and was baptized.

# **Saul's Immediate Activities**

Acts 9:19-22

<sup>19</sup> And after taking some food, he regained his strength.

Saul was with the disciples in Damascus for some time. <sup>30</sup> Immediately he began proclaiming Jesus in the synagogues: "He is the Son of God."

<sup>a</sup> All who heard him were astounded and said, "Isn't this the man in Jerusalem who was causing havoc for those who called on this name and came here for the purpose of taking them as prisoners to the chief priests?"

<sup>22</sup> But Saul grew stronger and kept confounding the Jews who lived in Damascus by proving that Jesus is the Messiah.

#### Saul's Immediate Activities Acts 9:19-22

- · Stayed for "some days"
- Proclaimed Jesus
- Increased in strength
- Confounded the Jews
- · Proved that Jesus was the Christ

#### The Plot in Damascus Acts 9:23-25

<sup>23</sup>After many days had passed, the Jews conspired to kill him, <sup>24</sup> but Saul learned of their plot. So they were watching the gates day and night intending to kill him, <sup>25</sup> but his disciples took him by night and lowered him in a large basket through an opening in the wall.

#### The Plot in Damascus Acts 9:23-25

Jews conspire

- Gates guarded
- · Saul escapes in a basket

#### **First Trip Back to Jerusalem** Acts 9:26-30

<sup>26</sup>When he arrived in Jerusalem, he tried to join the disciples, but they were all afraid of him, since they did not believe he was a disciple. <sup>27</sup> Barnabas, however, took him and brought him to the apostles and explained to them how Saul had seen the Lord on the road and that the Lord had talked to him, and how in Damascus he had spoken boldly in the name of Jesus. <sup>28</sup> Saul was coming and going with them in Jerusalem, speaking boldly in the name of the Lord. <sup>29</sup>He conversed and debated with the Hellenistic Jews, but they tried to kill him. <sup>30</sup>When the brothers found out, they took him down to Caesarea and sent him off to Tarsus.

#### **First Trip Back to Jerusalem** Acts 9:26-30

- Reaction of the Disciples
- · Barnabas' testimonial
- Preached / Disputed
- Another plot to kill Saul
- Caesarea, then Tarsus

#### **Result for the Church** Acts 9:31

"So the church throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and was strengthened. Living in the fear of the Lord and encouraged by the Holy Spirit, it increased in numbers.



Galatians 1:15-17


- Set apart by God

2 Corinthians 11:32-33

<sup>30</sup> In Damascus, a ruler under King Aretas guarded the city of Damascus in order to arrest me. <sup>30</sup>So I was let down in a basket through a window in the wall and escaped from his hands.
