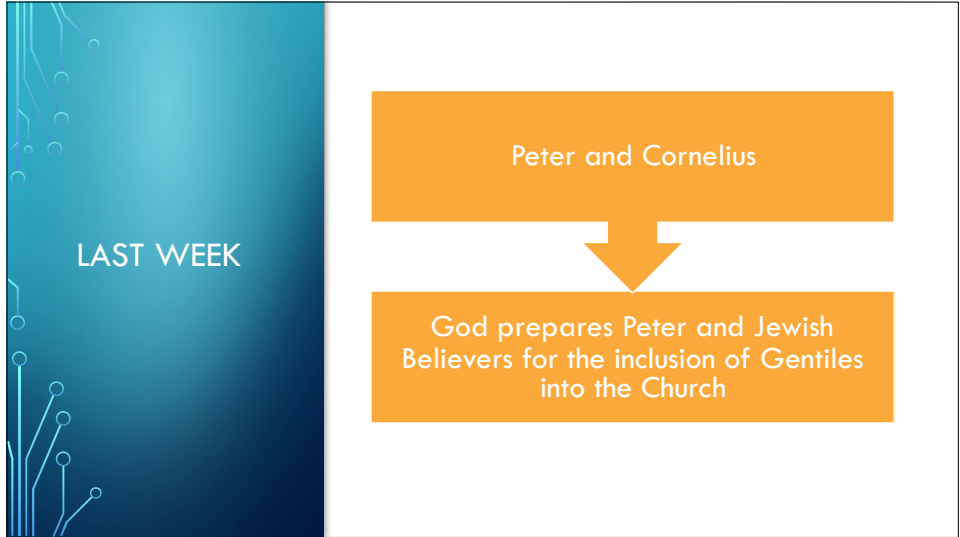

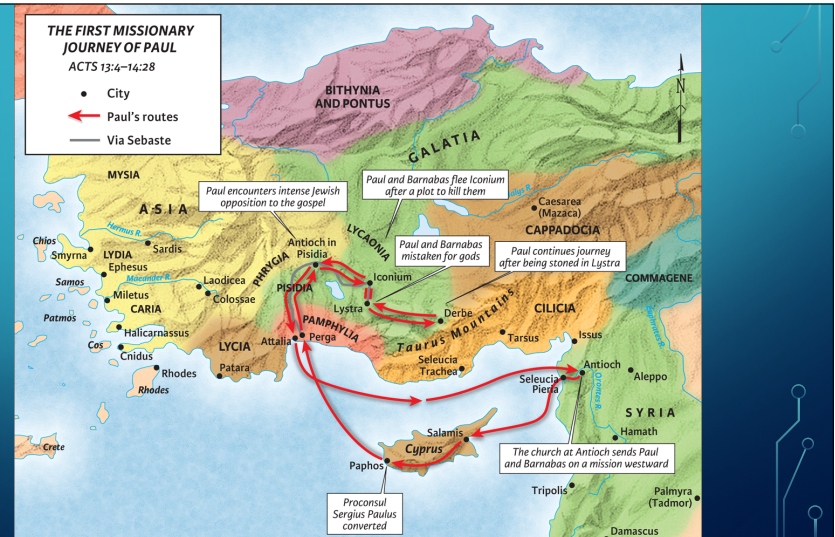
THE MESSAGE OF JUSTIFICATION BY FAITH IS FOR ALL PEOPLE

- Barnabas and Saul, with John Mark, return to Antioch (Acts 12:25)

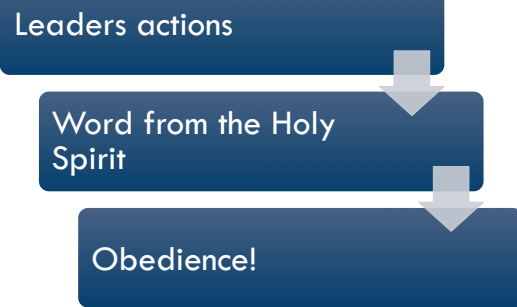
